There are **two types of ticket** available:

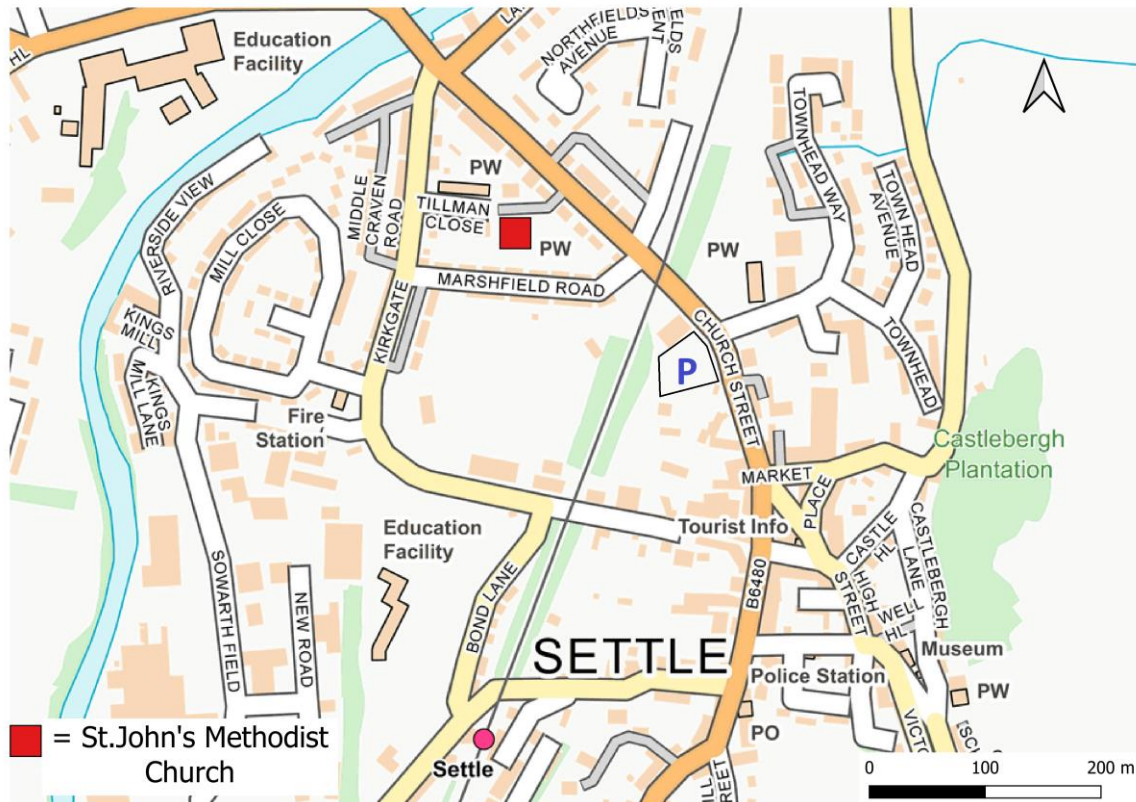
- 1) For those who wish to attend the AGM in person – this is to give us an idea of how many to arrange for at Settle.

Going north along Church Street, St. John's Methodist Church and Hall are the second turning on the left after going under the railway viaduct. It is about 10 minutes' walk from Settle Station (Train from Leeds at 9.19 arrives Settle 10.21; Depart Settle 16.28 arrives Leeds 17.38). There is very limited parking by the Church itself and that should be reserved for disabled members. On-street parking is available, and there is a large car park (£3.90 for more than 4 hours) next to the petrol garage.
